

R. C. A. TESTS FILMS FOR COLOR-TV SETS

Three Methods Devised for Transmission of Colored Movies Demonstrated

The Radio Corporation of America reported yesterday that it had demonstrated at Camden, N. J., three methods for transmitting film on color television. The test was made for engineering consultants of stations and networks.

One system under development, according to R. C. A., can pick up and reproduce color film that is projected by standard black-and-white film projectors. The system employs three tubes and mirrors.

Two other methods, it was said, employ special projectors used in conjunction with a device known as the flying spot scanner. The method designed for 16 mm. color film already is being field tested, the announcement added.
