

TV COLOR TICKETS GONE

Columbia May Have Second Week's Supply Tomorrow

The Columbia Broadcasting System announced yesterday that the first week's supply of complimentary tickets to its color television demonstrations had been exhausted. The public demonstrations start Tuesday on the ground floor of the former Tiffany building, 401 Fifth Avenue, near Thirty-seventh Street.

C. B. S. disclosed that 12,250 tickets had been handed out yesterday, the first day they were available, and that 15,000 requests had been received by noon. The network said it hoped to have the second week's tickets ready for distribution by tomorrow morning.

Tickets, when available, are distributed at C. B. S. headquarters, 485 Madison Avenue, the lobby at 401 Fifth Avenue, and the lobbies of the Commodore, New Yorker, Roosevelt and Wellington hotels. The network also will accept mail requests but none by telephone.
