

# **VIDEO CONFUSION CHARGED**

## **C. B. S. Tells Court That Is Aim of Foes of Its Color System**

In a memorandum to the Federal District Court in Chicago, the Columbia Broadcasting System yesterday accused the Radio Corporation of America and other manufacturers of trying to create confusion in television by seeking a preliminary injunction against the Federal Communications Commission's order approving the C. B. S. system of color television.

A temporary restraining order has been issued by the court pending study of material submitted in connection with the case. Columbia argued in the memorandum that the court did not have to study anything other than the reports by the commission.
