# **COLOR TV RULING SLATED**

## **Court Expected to Decide Today in Injunction Suit**

**CHICAGO, Dec. 21**—A three-judge Federal court is expected to issue a decision at 10 A. M. tomorrow on the injunction suit brought by the Radio Corporation of America against the Federal Communications Commission.

The R. C. A. asked the court last month to rescind a commission order which gave sole approval to the color television method devised by the Columbia Broadcasting System. The court issued a temporary restraining order on Nov. 15, barring the start of commercial color broadcasts by C. B. S.

Whatever the decision tomorrow, the case is expected to go to the United States Supreme Court.
